



2017 Sport Options Year 9 & 10, Term 2

Surfing - \$10 per week.

Learn to surf or simply go surfing with Newcastle Surf School. Enjoy being out on the water with your mates. Bring your board, swimmers, towel and sunscreen. Payment of \$100 for the term is required before commencing surfing.

Ice Skating - \$8 per week + \$35/term for bus

Mountain Biking- FREE

Beach Activities – FREE

Students who do not have their venue money on the day and/or full sport uniform will attend sport detention as Non-Sport participants.

Sports detention

Students who are unwilling to follow the school's sports policies and procedures are allocated a sports detention as a consequence. Sports detention runs during sport time and students are given work to do as a consequence for poor behaviour at sport. Sports detentions may only be issued by the sports coordinator or a member of the school executive. Parents/caregivers will generally be contacted when a student is allocated a sports detention. Further consequences may be issued for serious offences at sport or for persistent misbehaviour which results in several sports detentions during any given school term.
